THE CHALLENGE

To deliver a key part of the North-West Electrification Programme at Ashton under-Lyne railway station near Manchester.

WHAT WE DID

Working in collaboration with principal contractor, Buckingham Group, and track renewals contractor, Amey Sersa, we completed the reconstruction of all platforms and the subway within the station, and two underbridges carrying the railway over an adjacent road – all were situated within just a few metres of each other and in the middle of a busy urban environment.

THE RESULT

We achieved this critical milestone in the £500m programme during a 23-day blockade, marking a major step towards the overall project. Our collaborative approach, supported by our expert site teams and award winning plant fleet ensured that we developed an exceptional delivery solution that overcame the challenging time, logistics and space constraints and completed all work safely and on time.
