

Lookout/Site Warden

Course Aims

The aim of the course is to provide delegates with both the technical and non-technical skills and underpinning knowledge required to undertake their duties in line with its unit of competence.

This module forms part of the Lookout competence and is designed to train persons who are responsible for undertaking Lookout/Site Warden training as part of their duties on Network Rail Infrastructure

Primary Objectives

At the end of the training the delegate will be able to:

- Carry out the duties of Lookout/Site Warden to the standard of competence laid down in the knowledge and practical assessment
- Set up and operate PEE WEE and Kango warning equipment (optional)

Competence

The training will be followed by knowledge and practical assessments. The training provider will update Sentinel with the course results. To fully gain competence, the learner will be required to complete the Lookout e-learning module during their mentorship period.

Duration

Initial - 1 Days, 8 Delegates Max

Delegates

- Must hold a valid Sentinel Track Safety Card and meet the requirements of NR/L2/CTM/021 – Competence and Training in Track Safety
- Meet the medical requirements of Network Rail Standard NR/L2/OHS/00124 Competence Specific Fitness Medical Requirements
- Meet the requirements of Network Rail Standard NR/L1/OHS/051 (Drugs & Alcohol)
- It is the responsibility of the delegates local manager to decide upon their suitability to attend this course, in accordance with the current issue of NR/L2/CTM/021 – Competence and Training in Track Safety
